*Review***Modulatory effect of monosodium glutamate on rat thymocyte proliferation and apoptosis**

By using flow-cytometric analysis, we examined the effect of monosodium glutamate (MSG) on rat thymocyte proliferation, apoptosis and expression of Bcl-2 and Bax protein. MSG decreased thymocyte proliferation and increased apoptosis rate. These findings may, in part, result from down regulation of Bcl-2 protein and modulated Bcl-2/Bax protein ratio.

The treatment of hemorrhoids has undergone significant changes after introduction of new techniques during last years. Radiofrequency coagulation is a new approach for treating grade I and II hemorrhoids. In this procedure, the hemorrhoidal tissue is coagulated by a high frequency radio wave. Why does depression develop in complicated osteoporosis?

We recommend to use questionnaires No. 1 and 2 in female patients with acute painful vertebrae fractures to select patients with the risk of depression development. These patients should be followed more frequently as outpatients and in case of first clinical symptoms of depression should be recommended for special psychiatric care. Early therapy of depression enables to accelerate the mobilisation, rehabilitation and resocialisation of patients, to improve the quality of their lives and to reduce the costs of analgetic treatment of pain, sedatives and rehabilitation.
